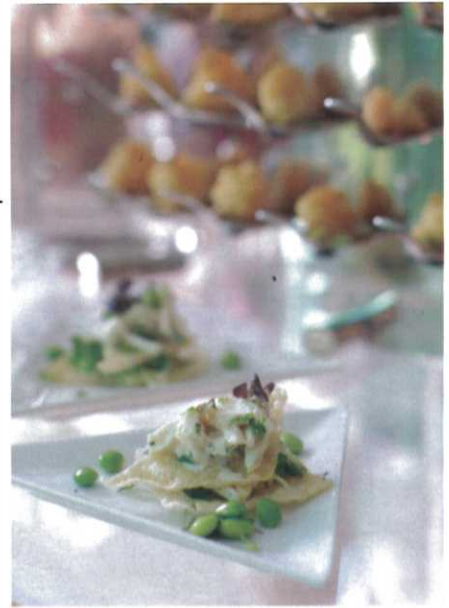
Timeless as Mozart, moving as a love letter penned in breathless exclamation, a wedding touched with the delicate detailings of baroque will exude modern day romance. Staged at the Birmingham Museum of Art Terrace Café, a modern interpretation of Old World finesse begins in pink and pewter color. Pink roses, hydrangea, orchids, mini callas, sweet pea and ranunculus, blended with berries and lily grass top the faux-iron backdrop, custom-made with bamboo lacquered in matte silver. Flower petals in varying shades of pink and white line the sides of the aisle and behind the nuptial site, providing soft accent to the bright, crisp setting and its silver chivari chairs. Bride Mary Caitlin McNeely wears an exquisite pink and ivory Justin Alexander gown as she holds a bouquet of sweet pea and ranunculus. Groom Chase Williams wears a two-button notch jacket and pant, white micro-fiber shirt, and Sterling Bali silver vest and matching Windsor tie. His boutonniere is a unique combination of wire, berry and ranunculus. This contemporary twist on a traditional color palette continues with elegant bridesmaid bouquets, made with pink mini calls, lily grass and berries. Ring bearer Brody Robbins holds a ring box, specially made by KG Designs, as Alaya Robbins takes a moment from her flower girl duties to enjoy the company of Remington, an Irish wolfhound. *Bridal gown provided by Bella Couture. 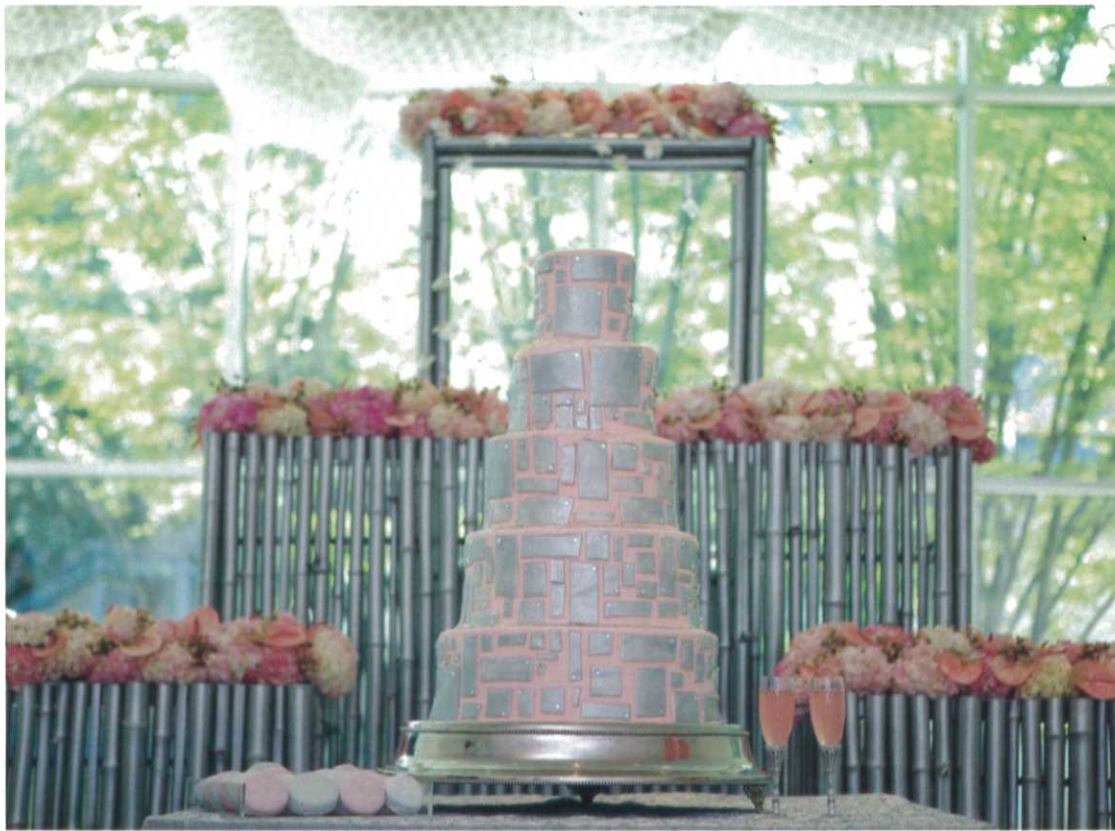
Upon a tabletop with glass legs filled with pink petals, waits a gorgeous spread of culinary delight! *From left to right:* Not your usual “ham & eggs” with roasted pepper grit cake, country ham, quail egg, and lemon Hollandaise sauce; Gazpacho on a spoon with savory pearls of tomato, avocado, limejuice and basil; Lump crabmeat salad with edamame, scallions, crisp wonton, lemon aioli, and micro opal basil; Crisp biscotti with pink and lavender icing; Spring lamb loin with mashed purple potatoes, snow peas, baby carrots, and port reduction; Spoon wall featuring tempura shrimp with avocado tomato salsa; Sushi balls of tuna and salmon, rolled with seasoned rice, lemongrass, wasabi, tobika, and orange caviar; Beijing pancakes topped with hoisin duck confit, julienned Asian vegetables, and crystallized ginger-lime aioli over mango Mandarin martini.





Dining will be a joy at a table set with a rich bounty of roses and Silver Bengaline and Steel Gray Pintuck linen, provided by BBJ Linen. China is stacked to create a unique and textured pattern: L'Objet Aegean platinum charger, Royal Limoges Oasis plate, and Annieglass ruffled platinum bowl. T. Davlin stemware and Vagabond House flatware in Whales pattern completes the opulent effect, all provided by Bromberg's. Menu cards and invitations by Weddings Etc. suggest an elegant affair.
